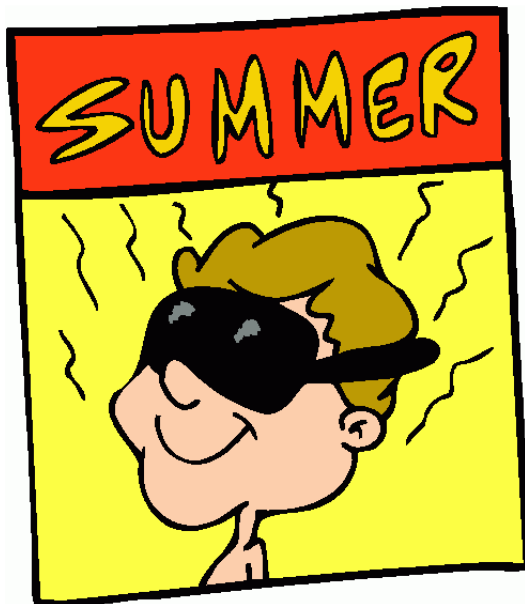

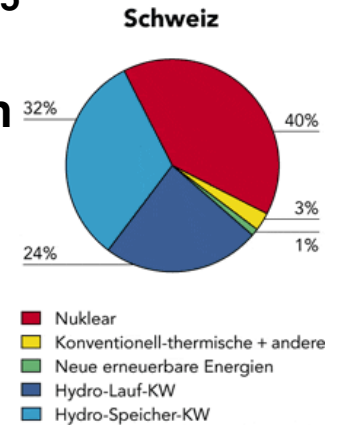

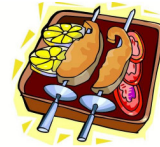

Numbers are limited. Therefore book by Thursday, 9th August at the latest. We only depart in good weather.

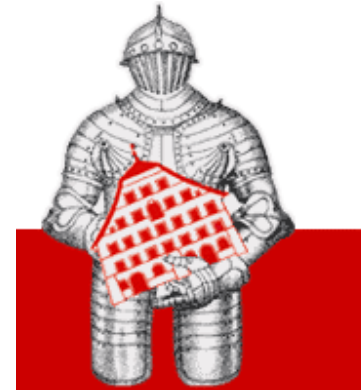
