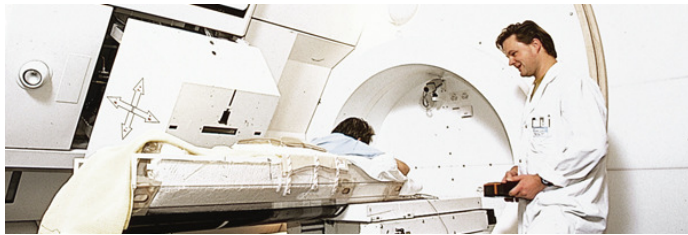

Meet at the PSI Forum at **13:45** (see map below)

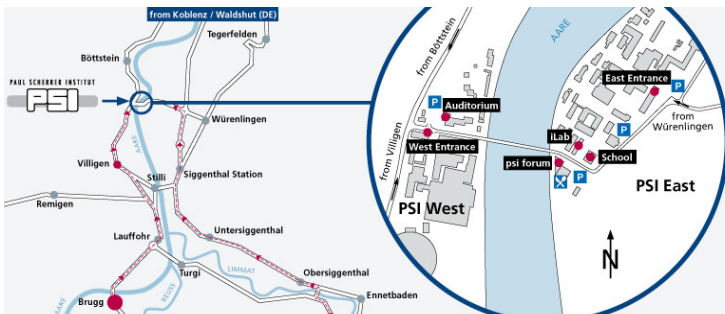
Proton Therapy at PSI



The Paul Scherrer Institute (PSI) is world-famous for its advanced treatment of tumours of the eye and deep-seated tumours in the body, using proton beams.

To keep us up-to-date with latest developments, we'll visit the PSI Forum and the therapy facility, with its own dedicated accelerator and new Gantry under construction. We'll find out how this all works and what happens to a patient before, during and after treatment.
