Visit to the 'Kerichtverbrennung' Turgi

Have you ever wondered what is happening to our rubbish after it has been collected by the lorry? To answer some of those questions, we have the possibility to visit the plant in Turgi.



84 villages or approx. 200'000 people send their rubbish to Turgi, where it is burnt. By doing that, energy is produced, as well as heat. The whole procedure is technical, but interesting, as it concerns all of us.

The visit will last approx. 1 ½ - 2 hours and the talk by the person in charge will be in German. However, we will be able to translate for those who are not yet perfect in the German language.
