Historic Museum Baden

The museum shows the varied and interesting history of the city of Baden from the first prehistoric findings to the roman period, the medieval city and to the 20th century. It is located in the old bailiwick castle and a modern building called “melon slice”



because of its form (by some also “million slice” because of its cost). After the visit we can go for a drink somewhere in Baden.

The entrance fee is CHF 7.— (CHF 5.— if we are a group of more than 8 people). No registration necessary. We meet by the entrance of the museum.

There is only little parking space close to the museum, however the museum is within 10 minutes walk from the station and various car parks (Ländli, Bahnhof, Theaterplatz, Aue etc.)
