## **Muri Abbey**



Muri Abbey is an extensive Benedictine monastery in the Freiamt, founded in 1027 by Ita, countess of Lorraine. It flourished for over eight centuries until the dissolution in 1841, and is an important part of the cultural heritage of Canton Aargau.

We will be shown the impressive interior of the Monastery, now partly occupied by local government offices, and told the history of each part. We will also see the cloister, with its stained glass from the Middle Ages, and finish our tour with a visit to the octagonal Baroque church with its famous organ.

We meet in the cobbled area in front of the church, and afterwards will go for a drink and a chat to the Restaurant Adler. The car parks Wiliweg (P1) and Käsi (P2) are free on Saturdays.
