## **Museum Langmatt, Baden**

The Museum is situated in a villa, built by the industrialists and art collectors Sidney and Jenny Brown in 1901 in the English country house style. We will have access to the family's former living quarters, workspaces and bedrooms and we



will be able to see their exquisite art collection with works of Camille Corot, Edgar Degas, Claude Monet, Pierre-Auguste Renoir, Paul Cézanne, Paul Gauguin and many others. There is also an exhibition of works of the internationally renowned Swiss artist Ursula Palla entitled Die fünfte Jahreszeit (The Fifth Season)

The entrance fee is CHF 12.-- (CHF 10.-- for students and pensioners). If we are more than 10 persons the entrance is free. No registration necessary. We meet at the entrance of the museum.

There is only little parking space close to the museum, however the museum is within 10 minutes' walk from the train station and various car parks (Bahnhof, Theaterplatz, Grand Casino, Power Tower etc.)
