Walk along the Reuss

There are also ponds with unusual waterfowls.

At the end of the walk, we can have a drink, or a snack, at the newly re-opened, and extensively

refurbished, restaurant in Gnadenthal.

This is an easy 2 1/2 hour walk with virtually no inclines, and much of it is through woods. For the thirsty or hot (hopefully)



there will possibly be an opportunity to slake one's thirst at a little camping-ground Beiz in Sulz before crossing on the ferry. In which case, we would add 1/2 hour to the walk.
