## **Walk to Kloster Fahr**



Kloster Fahr is a benedictine monastery of nuns, founded in 1130, and forms a unique double monastery with Einsiedeln. Although in Kanton Zürich it is an exclave of Würenlos, AG, and till this year was renowned for its agricultural school for women. It also boasts a herb garden, a vineyard, a garden restaurant, and, of course, a shop!

You will, however, have to earn your drink at the “Two Ravens” by walking for 45 minutes along the River Limmat from Fahrweid. Having indulged in refreshment we will walk back by a different footpath.

We meet in the car park at the entrance to the Unterengstringen Golf Club, Überlandstrasse 109, which you will see signposted on the right opposite a gravel works as you leave Dietikon towards Zürich along Überlandstrasse. For those coming by train, the station is Glanzenberg, from which a footbridge crosses the Limmat, and you should wait at the end of the bridge, which we should reach by 14:45. Do wear solid footwear, the path is rather stony, but quite level, no ups and downs.
