Aarau



Between 1240 and 1250, Aarau was founded by the counts of Kyburg. In 1283 it received its town charter by the Habsburgs. In 1415, it became subject territory of the canton of Bern. From March to September 1798, it was the capital of the Helvetic republic and since 1803 Aarau is the capital of our canton.

We will have a guided tour in the city and we will be given an insight into the interesting history of Aarau.

We meet in front of the tourist office (the former post office) in the old town, Metzgergasse 2, 5000 Aarau
