## National Museum Zurich



With its extraordinary 19th century architecture, the National Museum Zurich has been designated a historical

monument of national importance. The museum was built under the guidance of the architect Gustav Gull, a student of Gottfried Semper. It was officially opened in 1898. Gull drew on various historicizing architectural features from the late middle ages and the modern era..... The permanent exhibition of the museum consists of four parts: Swiss history, the art collection, rooms and furniture and the collection of weapons. In addition there will be an exhibition on Dadaism (Dada universal). After the visit (no guided tour) we can go for a drink somewhere in Zürich.

The entrance fee is CHF 10.— (free entrance for holders of the Schweizer Museumspass or Raiffeisen Member Cards).

No registration necessary. We meet in front of the main entrance of the Museum just opposite Zurich main station
