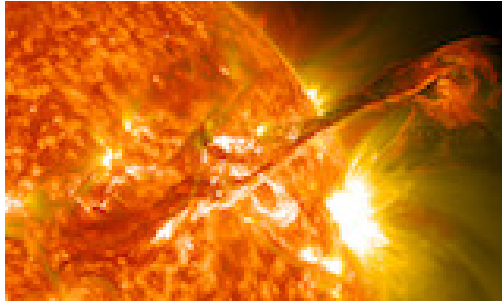


Sunday, 19th August, 13.45
