We meet at the parking at the top of the road between Steinmaur and Bachs (Eggstrasse, Steinmaur: 47°30'30.73"N, 8°26'57.28"E, google maps: <https://goo.gl/maps/sR68zh2yq3FqVUm47>).

The parking is signposted and located about 300m off the main road

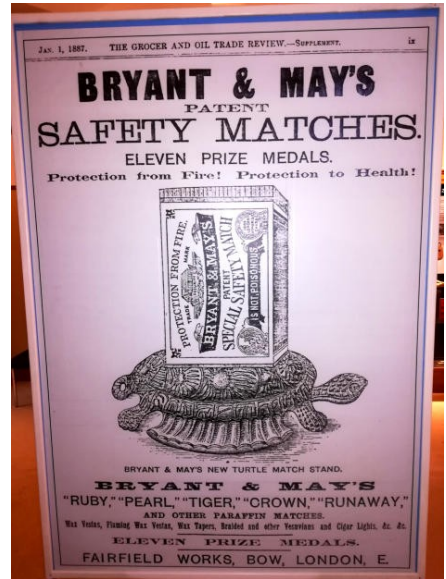
Coming from Leuggern it's the second house on the right.

Do you remember sewing name tags on to children's' clothes, and wondering how they weave the name into the cloth? And Sprüngli uses ribbons like this – a quality product produced by them. How is it made? On this visit to the hundred-year-old firm of Kuny we will find out, and a lot more besides. They produce a whole range of articles, e.g. 'Velcro', medical fabrics etc. They will even make special decorative bows for you.

We will be told the story of the firm, and then shown round the factory, where they have over 160 various tape looms, dyeing facilities and innumerable finishing processes.

We meet at the entrance to the factory, Benkenstrasse 39, Küttigen, at 09:45. You can take bus no. 135 or 136 from Aarau main station. The early start is on recommendation of our guide – all the interesting processes occur in the morning.

City tour Lenzburg



A walk through the old town of Lenzburg with an English speaking guide. The horseshoe shaped old town below the Lenzburg castle is well preserved. Part of the old town wall has been kept and is a national monument. The baroque style

buildings are from the 17th and early 18th century. The church is, however, from the 15th century and has an impressive Rococo ceiling. Lenzburg has many fountains, the oldest of which is the Chlaus fountain in the Metzplatz from the 14th century.
