Bohnerz (Eisenstein)

We visited the „Bergwerk Herznach“ in June 2018 where iron ore was mined. In keeping with this theme Bohnerz was collected near Wilchingen/SH. A 500 m long information path has been installed



which gives details of the history and the importance of this kind of iron ore. The area is on the southern part of the Randen (the last of the Jura mountains). www.bohnerzspur.ch
